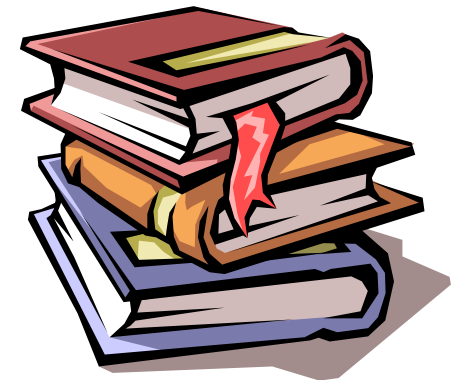

UCW BURSARY FUND

The Bursary Fund has been in existence for over 50 years.

Saskatchewan UCWs started it as a Centennial Project in 1967, its purpose being to support women who wanted to study at the Centre for Christian Studies in Toronto. That was the beginning.

Now the fund assists any student who is a member of a Saskatchewan United Church, entering a United Church recognized program of pastoral ministry.

Recipients of the Bursary Fund are serving in ministry in Living Skies Regional Council and beyond.



The UCW Bursary Fund provides funding directly to students training for ministry. As the cost of education increases, any support students receive becomes more and more valuable and appreciated.
