Background:

Through the generosity of the people of Living Skies Region, Youth and Young Adults have a unique opportunity for financial support and involvement with the United Church of Canada. The Youth Leadership Fund is overseen by a team of lay and order of ministry representatives with the Living Skies Region's Youth and Young Adult Community (YAYAC).

The Living Skies Youth Leadership Fund was established primarily to financially assist individuals attending Educational Events related to Faith & Leadership Development. Grants are provided to those youth and young adults most in need who may not otherwise be able to participate in events without the benefit of funding.

Grant Amounts:

The maximum grant for individuals will be 1/3 of the cost of the program/event, up to a maximum of \$400 per individual.

Recognizing the need for equitable stewardship of the funding, the maximum grant for a group application (6 or more individuals) will be 1/3 of the cost of the program/event *up to a maximum of \$3000 per group*.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1) Each application is assessed on its own merits. The primary questions to be considered are:
 - How will this experience enhance ministry by, for, and with Youth and Young Adults?
 - How will this experience encourage the involvement of Youth and Young Adults in the life of the United Church of Canada?
- 2) Proposals must be for programmes or events that the United Church of Canada would endorse as valid ministry for youth and young adults.
- 3) Proposals should enhance, enrich, and complement the programmes of the United Church of Canada (congregations, regions, ministries, General Council) in the area of youth and young adult ministry.

Please note that payment of financial grants is provided only after the event takes place, and an evaluation of the event has been provided by the participant. If it is necessary to receive grant monies prior to the event, please include an early payment request and explanation with your application.
