## **SASKATCHEWAN UNITED CHURCH OF CANADA WOMEN 2020 ANNUAL REPORT**

It is unfortunate that the Women's Retreats and a province wide Meeting were postponed in 2020, necessitated by the restrictions due to the Covid-19 Coronavirus pandemic.

Extensive planning was completed for the postponed April 24 to 26, 2020 Gathering in Prince Albert, refunds of deposits and cancellation of presenters were completed.

Tentative plans are being made for a Sask. UCCW Gathering/Meeting in September 2021 if an in-person meeting can be held. Otherwise, a Zoom Meeting of Saskatchewan members may be arranged.

The Executive consulted by telephone and e-mail. It met in person by October and December 2020 Zoom Executive meetings.

Dawn Weber, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice Chair and Barbara Byers Bradley, Secretary represented Saskatchewan United Church of Canada Women at the National UCW Annual Meeting held September 28 to October 2020 by Zoom. Our unit was assigned to provide Morning and Evening Meditations. National UCW Elections have been postponed as was the transfer of duties to President elect Nancy Risto from Horseshoe Falls Region. The UCW Handbook Committee Manual update is proceeding. Rev. Michael Blair's special closing worship service with communion was open to anyone wishing to register via Zoom. Rev. Blair assumed the new General Council Secretary position November 1, 2020. Full report of the NUCW Zoom Meeting is available. Due to the illness of President Beulah Hayley, a follow-up NUCW zoom meeting has been postponed. The representatives are

to consider a draft letter to General Council recommending UCW recognition as a constituent member of the United Church of Canada.

The 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of UCW is set for July 11 to 15, 2022 at Membertou Trade and Convention Centre in Sydney, Nova Scotia.

Monthly newsletters have been written, distributed by email and mail by Mary Mohn, Editor. She is our representative to the National UCW In Touch Newsletter [formerly *Keeping In Touch*]. The Sask UCCW Newsletters and revised Statistics Form are posted online at the Living Skies Regional website: [<https://livingskiesrc.ca/programs/ucw/> under Programs>Women's Network]. Mary Mohn has been appointed as Sask UCCW Communications Officer and contact person for Sask UCCW on the UCW webpage.

The Statistics Form 2020/2021 has been revised and circulated with a deadline date for returns by March 1, 2021. As at March 2020 there were 718 Saskatchewan UCCW Members. A 2021 project is planned for Dawn Weber and Barb Byers Bradley to personally contact all Living Skies Region pastoral charges and community of faith members and/or women's groups including UCWs to ensure we have correct contact information for Newsletters, Announcements, Gatherings, Meetings and Camps. Sask United Church of Canada Women is a "Network" that includes all UCW, and all women and individuals in the entire Province of Saskatchewan.

The Saskatchewan UCW Bursary Fund Committee members are Mary Mohn, Susan Dokken, Chantal Ntibategera, Allison Irvine, Joan Brown. The Bursary Fund Application Form and Pamphlet were revised, with thanks to Bev Diebert, to reflect the regional structure. Persons who are members of Living Skies Regional Council United Church community of faith and who are participants in a recognized program of preparation for pastoral ministry in the United Church of Canada may apply. Applications will be considered twice yearly, at the end of February and the end of October. Applications may be submitted once per year per person.

Four Bursaries were awarded totalling \$5,600.00. The Bursary Fund balance at year end, December 31, 2020, is \$8,461.00 including donations received in 2020 of \$7,247.00.

The United Church Women of Living Skies Region gave \$50,402 to Mission and Service in 2019. In total, UCWs across Canada and Bermuda gave \$1,020,034.00 to Mission and Service in 2019.

For the year 2020 an Election and Installation of an Executive has not been held because of the pandemic.

The executive of Sask. United Church of Canada Women met via Zoom on Saturday, April 10.

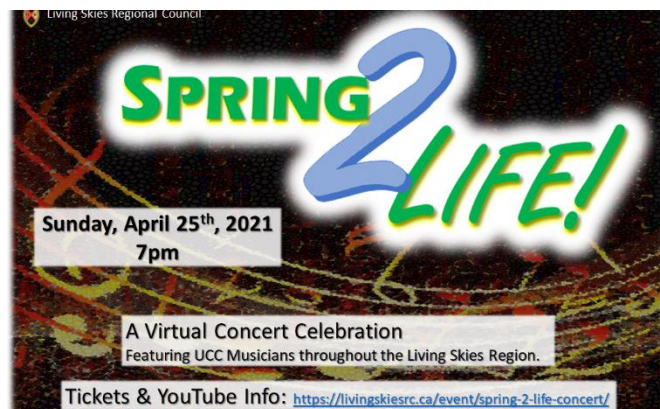
