| Property Fund | The Regional Council has a Property Fund and Prairie Pine Presbytery had a bulldozer fund, the commission will request that these funds be amalgamated; George will prepare a description of the fund including the purpose and name of the fund for our December meeting. |
| OTHER DECISIONS | |
| Insurance on Vacant buildings | St. James United Church in Lashburn is unable to find an insurance company to insure their vacant building. George advises that this may be due to their location. The Commission suggests they contact Hub International, the insurance company recommended by the United Church of Canada. |
| Assessments for congregations in process of disbanding | Congregations that are planning to disband and have ceased worshipping do not have income and therefore should not be expected to continue paying their United Church assessments. We are recommending that assessments be paid for the year in which the congregation ceased worship; but that no assessments be paid for subsequent years. |
| | Shannon advises that in the future we should send the list of congregations that have ceased worshipping to General Council in early October. Bev had prepared an email to Erik Matheson advising of congregations that are planning to disband and have ceased |

| | worshipping in 2020. This email was reviewed with some additions being made. |
