Schedule

The basic schedule for our time together has been arranged. The main points are that we are beginning at 2 PM (registration is earlier) on Thursday, and will have an outline that day of all the business that will come before us. Our plenary space is at the Exhibition Centre.

On Friday, we will be attending the *Heart of the Youth Community Pow Wow* for our morning and early afternoon activities. Lunch will be provided at the Pow Wow. Later, Friday, we will hear from one guest speaker, Chief Cadmus Delorme. We will discuss together the remit to be voted on, and the opportunity to renew our AFFIRM standing, as a Region now rather than as a Conference.

On Saturday, we will welcome guest speaker, Elder Liz Settee, and the Living Skies Youth will share with us. We will hold the voting, and we will discuss Clusters and Networks. Then, Saturday evening we are celebrating our Retirees and our Ordinand.

Sunday morning's Worship and Celebration will be at Calvary United Church. Other worship times will be woven throughout our gathering.

Amenities

Costs

We are very hopeful that people will plan to attend in-person.
