Gladys Leola Eileen Pavo Penny (nee Jones) passed away April 29, 2024 from the effects of a stroke. She enjoyed a long life full of family, learning, community service, travel, quilting and love of reading.

Gladys was born July 22, 1934 in Riverhurst, SK to Jean (McLaughlin) Jones and James Cecil Jones. Later in life, she would tell people that she grew up on a ranch under Lake Diefenbaker, because the Lazy J Bar Ranch on the banks of the South Saskatchewan River was expropriated for the construction of the Gardiner Dam.
