



The Archives is Looking for a New Location!

The Archives is in urgent need of a new home! As many of you know, the Living Skies Regional Council Archives has been housed at the Provincial Archives of Saskatchewan for many years. However, the provincial government has ended this agreement, and we must move our records by March 2025.

The Archives is looking to partner with a United Church within the province of Saskatchewan to house archival shelving, approximately 300 linear metres of records (and growing!), and an office for our part-time staff.

The Community of Faith would receive a dependable, long-term, and largely quiet tenant.

The Archives would receive a large, secure, and accessible space for storage of boxes, and permanent workspace for the archivist and occasional archives visitor. The Archives has a list of needs and wants, which are listed on the following page.

Does your Community of Faith mostly meet these needs? Would you be interested in starting a conversation and seeing if we may be a good fit for each other? If so, the Archives would be delighted to hear from you!

If your Community of Faith is interested in participating in an initial conversation or has any questions then please reach out to the archives staff at **livingskiesarchives@united-church.ca** If interested, please send an **Expression of Interest by September 30th, 2024.** If you require more time, please send an email noting your interest with more details to follow.

The Expression of Interest should include: your assessment of your strengths and weaknesses vis a vis the Archives' list of needs and wants; the dimensions of the potential space (including square footage and max/ min length, width, and height); a description of the space and photographs; information about the contact person(s); and anything else you'd like to share. It is unlikely that any one building will meet every need/ want that the Archives has, so please reach out if interested, even if you're not a "perfect" match.



Is there someone in the building every day? Could someone do brief		
walkthroughs of the space most days?		
Is it feasible to host the Archives for at least 10 to 20 years? (Knowing that		
none of us can predict the future!)		
Where in Saskatchewan are you located?		
Does the potential space have a door? With a lock? Could it be made secure		
with some renovations?		
Does your potential space require minimal or extensive renovation before it		
would be useable?		
Is there an elevator?		
Is there a temporary workspace that could be occasionally used by archival		
researchers?		
Is there a permanent office space that could be leased by archives staff?
