# Fall 2024 Olive Harvest Focus: Resources for further learning



As farmers bring in their crops across Canada, we'll connect with the olive harvest in Palestine. In the West Bank and Gaza the olive industry is very important. Many families inherited their trees going back generations, so there is enormous family pride in the trees and a strong sense of rootedness in the land. The trees are tough. They are resistant to drought and can survive in poor rocky soil. To Palestinians olive trees are powerful symbols of resilience, permanence, and resistance. They are much

more than a source of income; they are integral to the Palestinian identity. They are holy.

The significance of olive trees to Palestinians has made them a target for Israeli settlers. Around the harvest season in particular, which traditionally is a community celebration, Israeli settlers harass farmers, spray crops, destroy and vandalize trees. Between 2000-2017 over 500,000 olive trees were uprooted by Israeli authorities and settler violence.
