Raymond John Lewis Purdie, late of Regina, SK passed away peacefully on Saturday, July 11, 2026 at the age of 80 years. He was predeceased by parents Reid and Beatrice, and grandson Keaton. Raymond is survived by spouse Judie (daughter of John and Mary McDougall of Craven, SK); daughter Erin of Whitehorse, YT; son Brendan of Vittoria, ON; son Chad of Saskatoon, SK; daughter Megan of Saskatoon, SK; grandchildren, Levi, Emily, Josh, Tristana, Brady, and Ethan; brother Don of Kelowna, BC; as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

Ray Purdie was a much-beloved minister in Living Skies Regional Council, serving in many communities of faith including Bradwell-Lost River, Spiritwood (Glaslyn, Shell Lake and Spiritwood), and Lanigan-Nokomis. A significant portion of his ministry was spent serving as chaplain at Sherbrooke Community Centre in Saskatoon. Most recently, he served at St. Andrew's United Church in Imperial with such dedication that he engaged in a series of ever-shorter but nonetheless committed appointments to best meet everyone's needs until he retired completely in 2023. Ordained at St. Andrew's College with the infamous class of 1988, Ray will be missed for his wisdom and insight, collegial support, beautiful singing, and sense of humour that twinkled in his eyes.
